Your child's safety at 3pm pick up time is of paramount importance. We know that and you know that too.

Hence we want to work with you to help keep all our children safe, particularly at this busy time.

Please read this leaflet, consider the points raised within it, talk to your child and keep your child and others safe.

THINK

SAFETY FIRST

We have spent time considering various options at 3pm, including asking you as parents. Below are our key concerns:

Key Concerns:

- Child running into oncoming traffic
- Children playing in front of school while parents talk
- Sometimes children not released in time from class and holding up pick up times
- Small toddlers and children not being held by parents' hand
- Speed of cars driving through
- Children crossing the road to parents on opposite side
- Children getting into a vehicle on non-pavement side of car
- Double parking and slowing up traffic flow
- Parking in the 'No Parking' area

NO DOUBLE PARKING

What we have shown your child already:

1. Modelled how to remain in line in a safe area before you arrive
2. Shown them 'blind spots' from the driver's point of view
3. Modelled how to get into and out of the car from the pavement side
4. Shown the importance of WALKING ONLY on the school pavement
5. Pointed out hazards of playing while parents are chatting at 3pm



Keeping your child safe until you collect

Pupils will remain behind our fence until you collect your child.

Pupils will NOT CROSS the road in front of the school to the car park unless you come over for them.

What we are asking of parents

1. Drive at a speed of less than 10mph along the school driveway
2. Walk to the front entrance and pick up your child.
3. Hold onto younger siblings by the hand at all times.
4. Do NOT allow your child to play or run on the grass or field at this time.
5. If parked opposite the school door in the school carpark, please cross the road and take your child safely across.
6. Use any car park spaces available.
7. First car into the grounds should park up near the EXIT gate.
8. NO DOUBLE PARKING- this slows up traffic flow. Wait at the entrance gate for a space to become available.
9. Collect your child promptly.
